

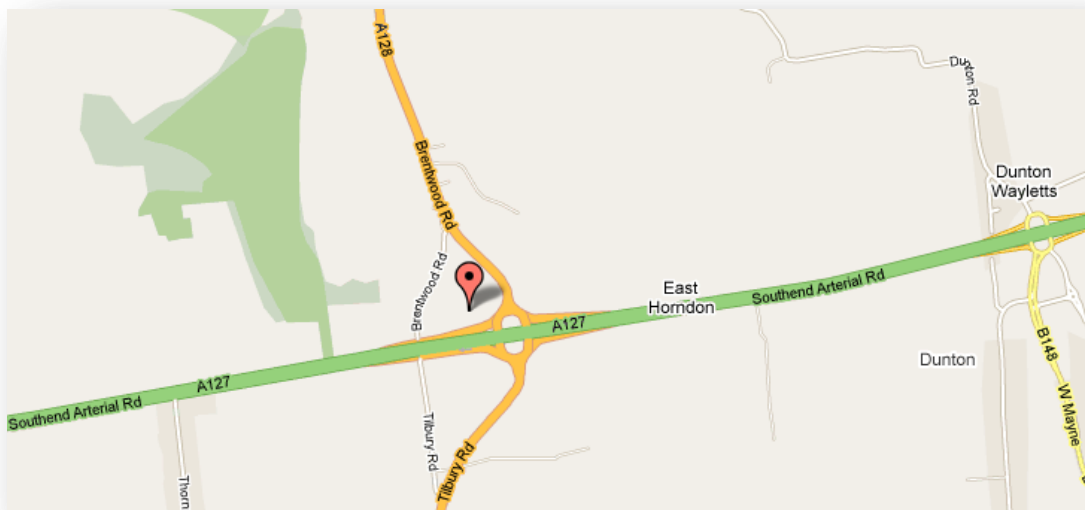
potiphar's apprentices

potiphar's apprentices are a local folk music group who specialise in the original folk songs and music of Vaughan Williams who visited Ingrave, Herongate and West Horndon in the early 20th century and used local folk songs to influence his work. The local Brentwood folk group aim to return the folk songs back to the community.



See ***potiphar's apprentices*** for yourself, when they perform in the beautiful and acoustic **Church of All Saints, East Horndon, at 7pm on 30th July 2011**. The performance is free, but there will be a retiring collection in aid of the Friends of All Saints, East Horndon, who are currently trying to raise £3,500 in order to fit the church with an electronic doorlock, enabling daily daylight access to the church for all visitors.

The church is at the junction of the A127 and A128, and is reached via the Brentwood Road.
